
Plain Bob Doubles Happy Families

Instructions

- Print out two copies of the sheets. It's worth using different coloured paper if you are going to use several different games that might get mixed up.
- Laminate if possible, for durability.
- Cut into individual cards.

Playing Happy Families

- Make sure that the cards have been well shuffled.
- Deal four cards to each player.
- Place the remaining cards face down in the middle.
- Turn up the top card to form a discard pile.
- The first player may either pick up the card facing up or may take the card from the top of the face down pack.
- The player must then choose a card to discard face up.

The aim is for the players to collect the correct cards to complete a plain course of the method.

When a player thinks they have the required pieces for a plain course, they should place them in the correct order for the rest of the players to agree. If correct, the player wins and scores a point.

Re-shuffle and play the game again. The first person to score three points is the winner – or any agreed number, depending on time available.
