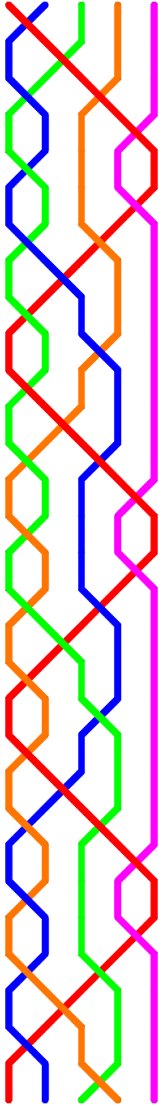


Sussex Place Doubles



Purpose

Sussex Place is a simple doubles method, where the fifth place bell rings long back work with clear treble signposts. It provides an opportunity to practise steady covering and develop ropesight. The bell which the fifth is following remains steady for long periods so should be easy to spot.

Ringing Sussex Place Doubles

The treble plain hunts.

Fifths place bell:

- Lies at the back (three blows), covering two of the working bells.
- Make two blows in fourth place under the treble,
- Lie at the back (eight more blows) until you meet the treble again.
- Repeat.

The bell which you were following prior to the treble arriving is the same bell you will follow when ringing two blows in fourths, and you will continue to follow it as you return to fifth place.

Bells 2 ,3, and 4 ring the method.
